The other qualifications might mean you will have to get further theological training. And as you know, every Chosen People Missionary raises his or her own support. Why not ask the Lord, "Are you calling me to a ministry among the Jewish people?" I hope you will pray that prayer.

Be a Church Ministries Coordinator for Chosen People Ministries

There are many behind-the-scenes positions that provide support for our missionary staff. None is as important as Church Ministries Coordinator. Church Ministries Coordinators contact churches, Messianic congregations and schools for Chosen People Ministries missionaries and other Mission representatives to present our calling.

STEP (Summer Training and Evangelism Program) has served as a gateway to STEP into Jewish Evangelism Jewish missions for hundreds of people in the past years. There is simply no better way than STEP to "try on" Jewish evangelism and see how it fits.

This four-week U.S. program (June 8-July 6) begins in Chicago at the Moody Bible Institute. There, STEP participants will learn about Jewish religion,

history and culture—and receive training in Jewish evangelism that will shortly be put to full use on the streets of New York City, the heartland of Jewish life in America.

Once in New York, STEPpers are joined by Chosen People Ministries staff members for outreach evangelism and visits to Jewish cultural sites. The highlight is July 4th, when literally hundreds of thousands of New Yorkers gather in Manhattan to watch the fireworks display over the East River. On that day alone, STEP volunteers and Chosen People Ministries staff typically distribute 20,000-40,000 tracts.

And now this year STEP will be held in Canada also. Be sure to see the back page for information about our STEP Canada outreach July 31-August 15.

Regardless of your level of knowledge, the STEP program is designed to provide practical skills and spiritual insights that you will take with you for the rest of your life. The Chosen People Ministries staff will help in every way possible to make this four-week short-term mission meaningful for you and fruitful for the Messiah's kingdom. Step-in-a-Week

If you don't have a full four weeks to devote to Jewish evangelism this summer, don't despair! For the past two years, Chosen People Ministries has offered Step-in-a-Week, a one-week immersion in Jewish evangelism and culture (July 11-18). There are over five million Jewish people living in the Land of Israel—from all walks of life. You might find yourself rubbing elbows at a shop with an ultra-Orthodox Jew in Jerusalem, or maybe you'll be swimming at a beach and have the opportunity to witness to one of Israel's secular, atheistic



Short-Term Summer Opportunities with Chosen People Ministries

Although there might be snow on the ground where you are living and icicles hanging from the eaves—summer is coming! Before we know it, the summer months will be upon us. So, before time grows short, we want to showcase some of Chosen People Ministries' short-term missions opportunities. They just might be what you or someone you know have been seeking.

The seventh chapter of the Book of Revelation is a vision of suspense and majesty. Four angels hold back the forces of nature in a mighty moment of proclamation. The twelve tribes to which the 144,000 Jewish witnesses belong appear as a heavenly roll call (Revelation 7:5–8). They, in turn, are associated with the salvation of an enormous Gentile host.

Ultimately, Jewish witnesses will fulfill the Great Commission as given by the Messiah in Matthew. 24:14, "And this Gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come." The Lord also declared to Isaiah that His people Israel were to be His special witnesses: "You [Israel] are My witnesses, says the Lord, and my servant

whom I have chosen..." (Isaiah 43:10). Meanwhile, Revelation 7 emphasizes three demonstrations of God's grace during the Tribulation Period.

SPECIAL PROTECTION IN MINISTRY (Rev. 7:3)

All the witnesses are sealed on their foreheads and protected from harm until they accomplish their ministry. In contrast to the "mark of the beast" (Revelation 13:17), the 144,000 have the Father's seal inscribed on their foreheads (Revelation 7:3). This special mark of ownership secures their protection until their witness work is accomplished. The seal of ownership guarantees their arrival in heaven (Revelation 14:1-3). Today all believers are sealed with the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 1:13,14).

THE SUPERNATURAL PRESERVATION OF ISRAEL (Rev. 7:4-8)

The identity of the Jewish people in relation to the tribes of Israel is problematical, as the genealogical records were destroyed when the Temple was burned in AD 70. The ten so-called "lost tribes" were deported to Assyria in 721 BC. But nothing is lost to a covenantkeeping God! Even though the tribe of Dan is excluded from the list in Revelation 7:5-7 and Joseph is named instead of his son Ephraim, no tribe is ultimately lost. Ezekiel lists all the tribes of Israel for inheritance of the Promised Land when Messiah Himself will return. There we see Dan and Ephraim are included (Ezekiel 48:1-6). The Lord has promised supernatural preservation for His witnesses throughout the ages (Psalm 89:30-37).

REPENTANCE AND REVIVAL (Rev. 7:9,10)

Until the time of Messiah's first arrival, the greatest Gentile revival of all time was the repentance of Nineveh under Jonah's preaching (Luke 11:29-32). Here in Revelation 7:9 is the greatest revival of Gentile believers of all time, before the Second Coming of the Messiah. The text indicates that "a multitude which no man could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples" are regenerated. What a demonstration of God's grace in the Tribulation time!

JEWISH WITNESSES IN EVERY AGE

In every age, God specially employs Messianic Jews as His witnesses. In Old Testament times, Israel gave us the prophecies that Messiah Jesus has fulfilled. In New Testament times, Jewish evangelists like Paul planted churches among the Gentiles. In the terrible Tribulation time, the true Jewish witnesses of Revelation 7 will win a great multitude. Little wonder then that we are given the Biblical priority that the Gospel is "for the Jew first and also for the Gentile" (Romans 1:16).

Two Salvation Decisions in Southern California

Mark Ellick and Olivier Melnick, Chosen People Ministries missionaries in Southern California, recently visited Janice and Roger*—a Jewish woman and her husband to whom they had been witnessing. Roger was in the end stage of cancer, and once again, they shared the Gospel with him. Clearly, God had been working on Roger's heart, as he was ready to receive Yeshua as his Savior. Mark led Roger, whose voice was barely a whisper, in a prayer of salvation. Next, they turned their attention to Janice. She was hesitant, but after some conversation and questioning, she also prayed to receive the Lord. Roger died two days later, and now both he and Janice are resting in Messiah's peace.

A "HANDPICKED" GROUP FORMS BIBLE STUDY

Randall and Luda Ford have begun English/Bible classes in Queens, New York. All the students except one are unbelieving Jewish people, and most of them are Bukharan Jews, the unreached sub-culture that Randall and Luda feel called to reach. None of the students had ever heard that Jesus is the Jewish Messiah foretold in Hebrew Scripture. The community center in the complex where the Fords live in Queens has provided space, and Randall and Luda are greatly encouraged. They say, "God seems to have handpicked each of the students!"

ORTHODOX JEWISH MAN PRAISES MESSIANIC CONGREGATION

Recently, an Orthodox Jewish man began attending services at the Messianic congregation in Montreal led by Percy Johnson. At first, the man just watched and listened. Then one day, he said to Percy, "I was looking for a place where I would feel at home, and I think I've found it. I see such joy here! Never in all my 55 years of attending synagogue have I seen services like this. If I had raised my own children like this, they would not have left Judaism. If there could be more congregations like this, more Jews would come back to their God." What a blessing!

PRAYER UPDATE FROM FRANCE

Many friends of Chosen People Ministries have expressed prayerful concern for Daniel Solomon, the Mission's outreach worker in France, who was diagnosed some months ago with a terminal illness. We are happy to report that Daniel's health is improving. However, he will not be able to continue with the work. Before he became ill, Daniel had been able to bring unity to the work in France, and he established excellent relationships with different ministers. Guy Athia, an old friend of the

Mission, has been helping in the work. Please keep the Solomons in your prayers.

WORK IN MEXICO EXPANDING

Elias and Rosa Habif, Chosen People Ministries' missionaries in Mexico, have much to rejoice about. From

a group of three women who began to meet in the Habifs' dining room three years ago, the Messianic fellowship has grown to over 50 people. Last year, the Habifs started another congregation in Pachuca City, about 50 miles from Mexico City, and it already numbers 30 people. A member from the Pachuca City congregation has offered to donate land for our future Messianic Jewish facility there. Both fellowships consist of Jewish and non-Jewish people and have been reaching out to non-



believing Jewish people, praying for them and inviting them to Bible studies and special services.

PHONE CALL LEADS TO FAITH DECISION

Steve Fenchel, Chosen People Ministries' congregational leader in New York City, recently received a telephone call from Jacob, * a Jewish man in his late thirties who called with spiritual questions. Steve invited him to meet, and the next day, after sharing the Gospel, Steve led him to the Lord. Jacob has started to attend services and is eager to learn what it means to be a Jew who believes in Messiah Jesus. Jacob will be the first person baptized in our New York City congregation and, as Steve says, "He came into our midst because he had heard that we would speak to Jewish people about faith in God!"

ORTHODOX JEWISH MAN MAKES FAITH DECISION

Isaac,* an Orthodox Jewish young man, recently contacted our staff in Brooklyn through a series of referrals that involved relatives in Israel and the United States. Isaac asked serious questions about Jesus and also requested a New Testament. Then he started calling three or four times a week. After the first week, his calls came from Israel, where he had journeyed because of the death of his grandmother. During one of their discussions, our staff member sensed that Isaac was ready to accept Yeshua, and they prayed together that evening. Our worker wrote, "Isaac prayed from his heart as if he had done so all his life." Please pray for Isaac to grow as a new follower of the Lord and for salvation for his entire family.
